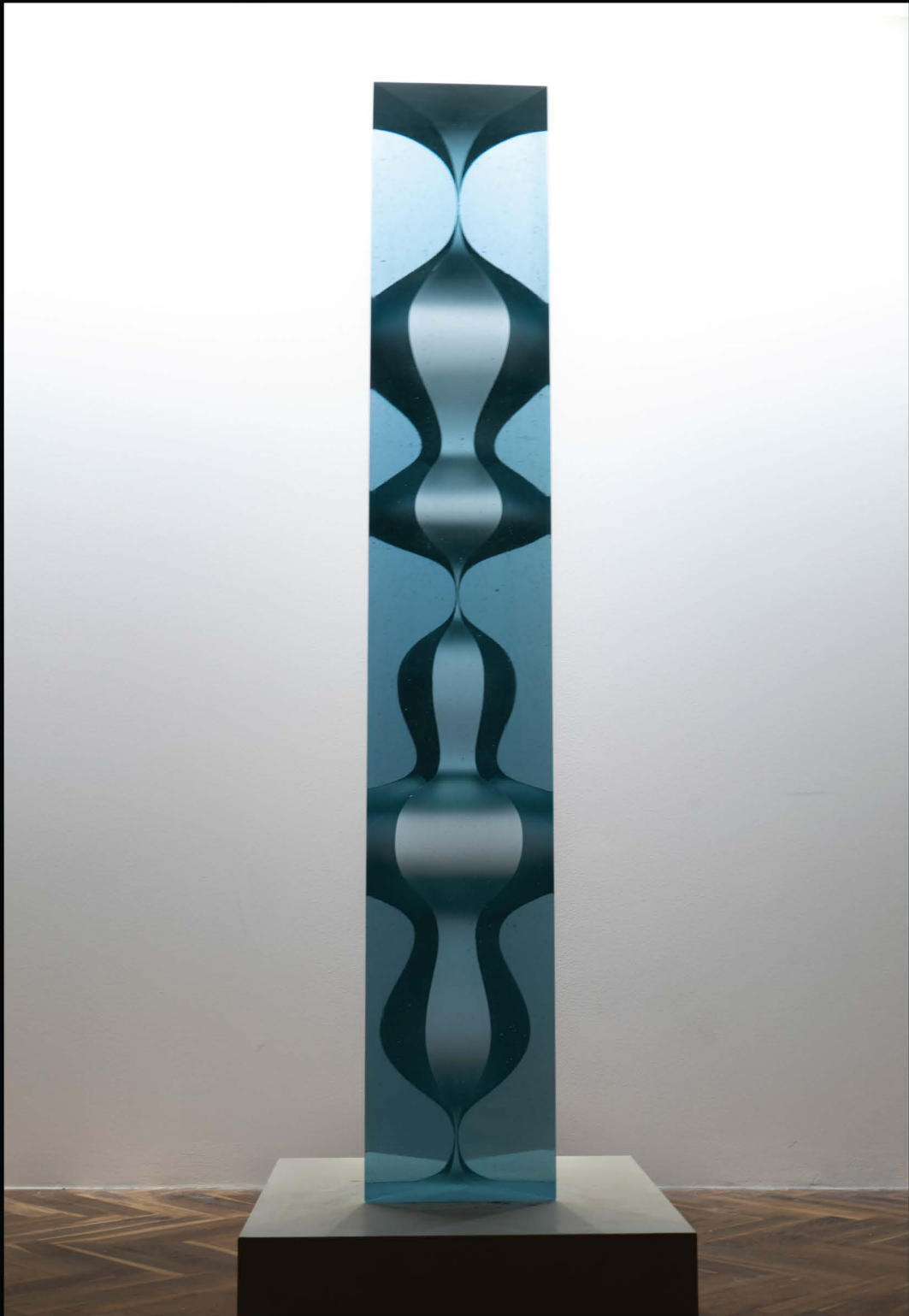

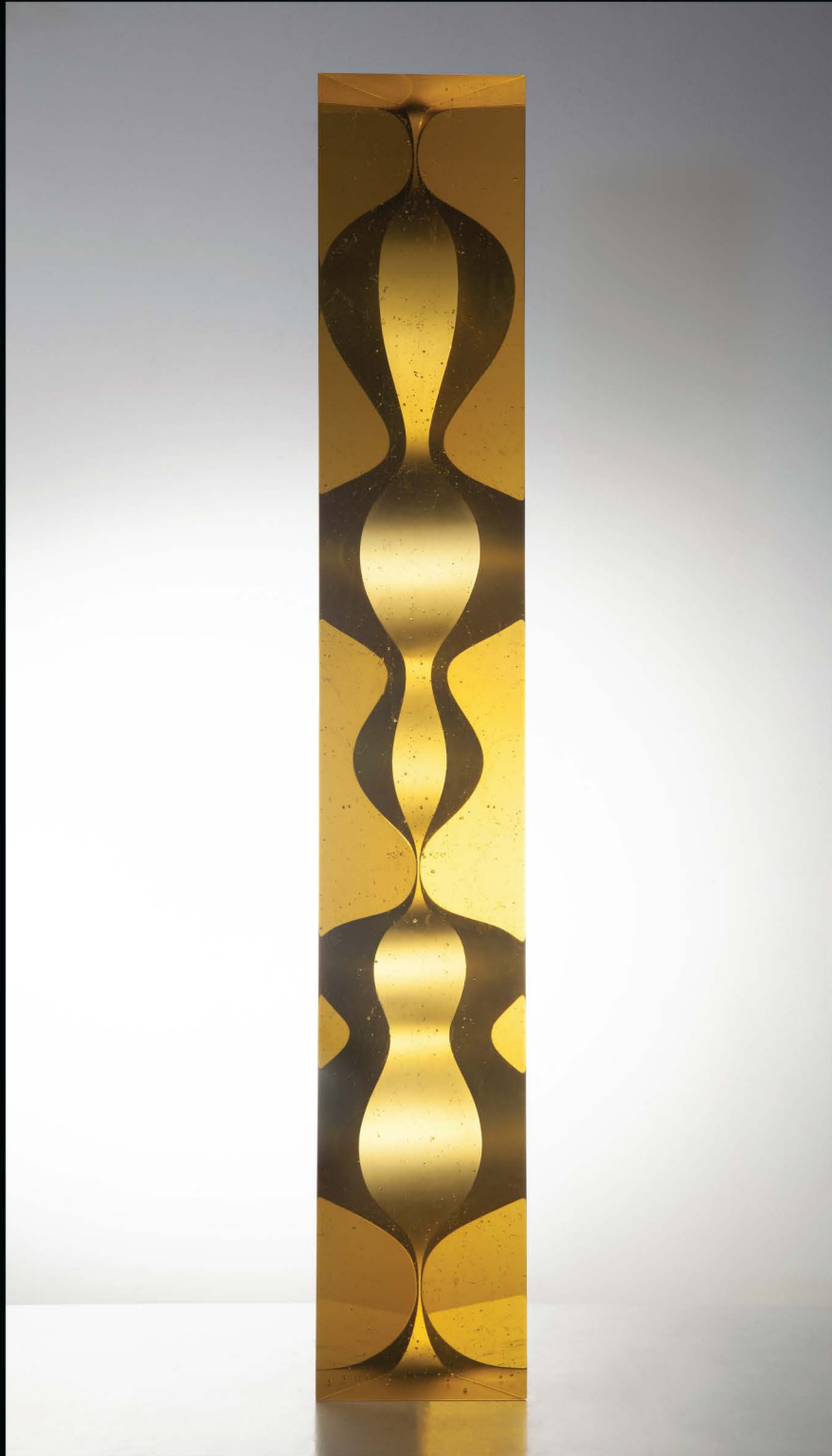
VLADIMIRA KLUMPAR, considered by many to be among the most influential Czech glass sculptors, has been sculpting in a variety of media since her early beginnings in 1974 as a student of Professor Stanislav Libensky and Jaroslava Brychtova. In “Forces of Nature” Klumpar has pushed the bounds of possibilities within the medium of cast glass, creating monumental works with a masterful sensitivity to the material.

Klumpar is the recipient of a Pollock-Krasner Foundation Grant. The artist’s works are included in many private and public collections including the Museum of Art and Design, New York, the Corning Museum of Glass, and the Palm Springs Art Museum, among many others.

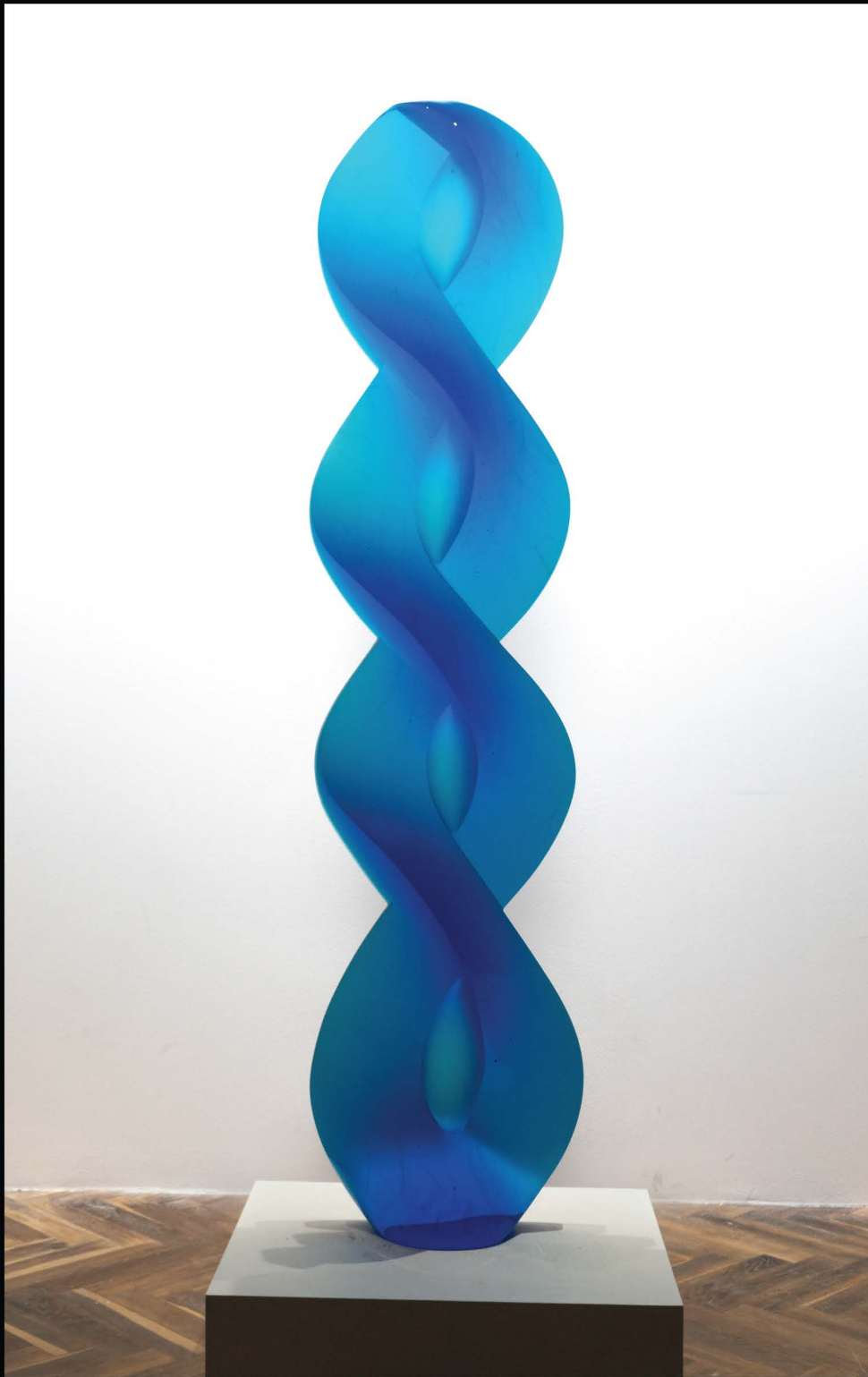

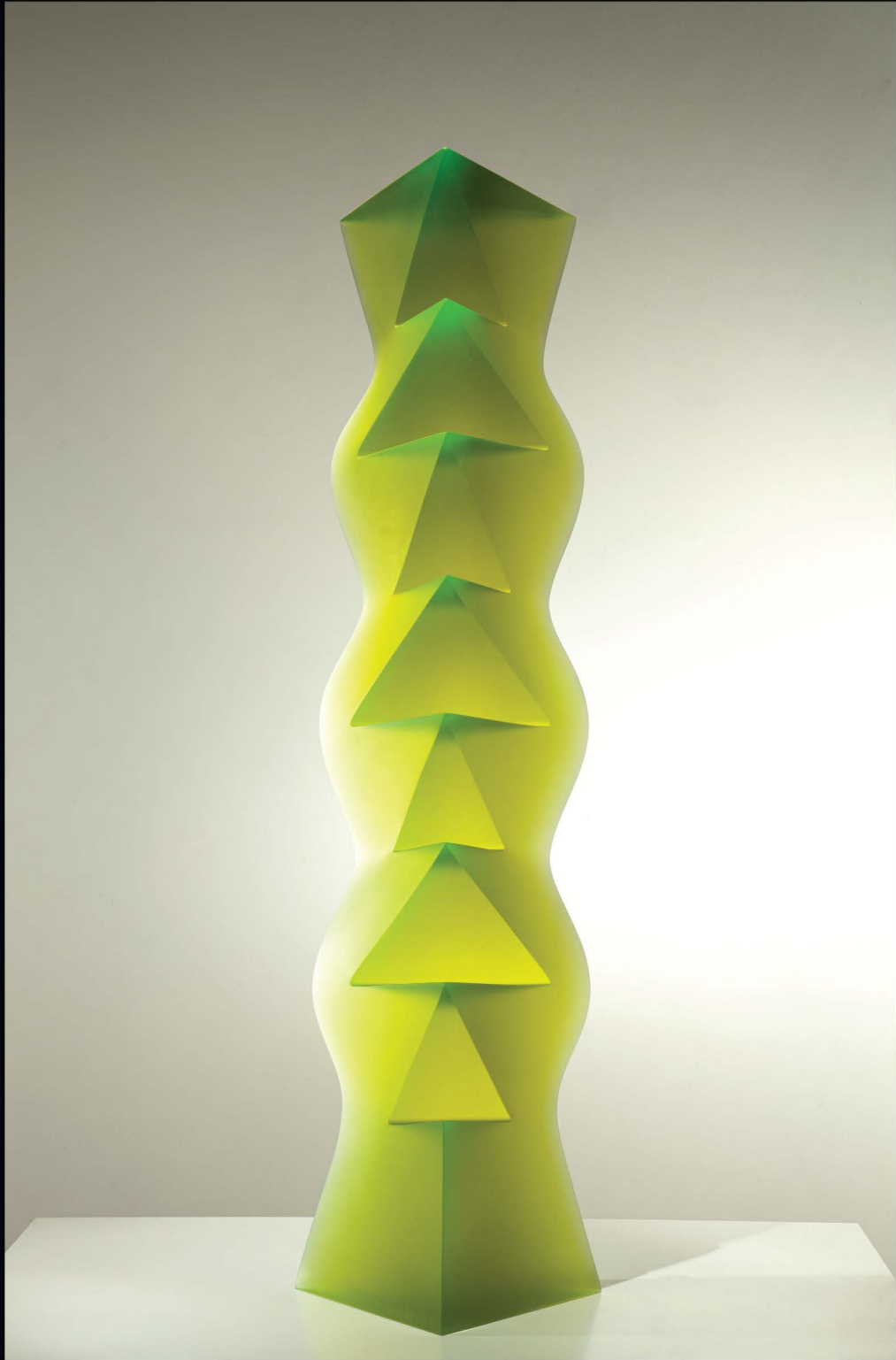
